

## Homeschool Course Description

Interactive Bible Curriculum · Kindergarten through 8th Grade

### Course Overview

TDW Kids is an interactive, self-paced Bible curriculum for Kindergarten through 8th grade, available through a monthly subscription at [tdwkids.com](http://tdwkids.com). Students work through the whole Bible — Old and New Testament — one lesson at a time, reading Scripture directly, answering questions, playing review games, and memorizing verses. Every lesson is differentiated by grade level so a Kindergarten and an 8th grader can study the same passage at the same time, each at their own reading level and depth.

Entirely web-based, works on any device, and requires no downloads. Each lesson takes 20–40 minutes and earns up to 6 stars across reading, story, gospel connection, memory verse, review game, and deep-dive library content.

### Grade Level Differentiation

All grades study the same lesson and Scripture passage. Bible version, content depth, and question complexity are automatically matched to each student's grade.

### Lesson Structure — 6 Sections per Lesson

#	Section	Description
1	Open Bible	Students read the Scripture passage in their grade-appropriate Bible version. Read-aloud audio available for all grades.
2	The Story	The passage retold with context and illustrations. Students confirm reading and answer comprehension questions.
3	Gospel Connection	How this passage points to Jesus. Depth scales by grade — from basic connection (K–1st) to reasoning with cross-references (6th–8th).
4	Memory Verse	A key verse from the passage. Verse Builder game with fixed blank counts: 2 rounds for K–1st, 3 rounds for 2nd–8th.
5	Review Game	Rotating games matched to the lesson: Word Search, Story Sequencer, Matching, Rapid Fire True/False, or Cause & Effect.
6	Deep Dive Library	Optional extended reading on background topics. Each article has read-aloud audio and a grade-level selector.

## Learning Objectives

By the end of each lesson, students will be able to:

- Identify the key people, places, and events in the passage
- Explain the main lesson or truth the passage teaches
- Connect the passage to the Gospel — how it points to Jesus
- Recite the memory verse for the lesson
- Define key vocabulary from the passage at their grade level

### 6th–8th Grade Additional Objectives:

- Read Hebrew and Greek terms with pronunciation guides and plain-English definitions provided in the lesson
- Trace cross-references connecting the passage to other parts of the Bible
- Analyze what specific details, word choices, and cultural context reveal about God and His plan

## Assessment & Progress Tracking

TDW Kids uses a star-based mastery system. Students earn up to 6 stars per lesson — one per section. Stars require both completing the reading AND answering questions correctly (100% required for reading sections; 60% minimum for review games). Any section can be retried unlimited times.

### Parent & Teacher Tools

- Parent Dashboard — set each child's grade level, control which lesson is active, view stars and streaks
- Progress Report — printable per-child report showing stars earned, lessons completed, and activity history
- Weekly Email Digest — automatic summary of each child's activity sent to the parent on file
- Admin Panel (for churches & co-ops) — manage multiple students, view grade breakdowns, send targeted emails
